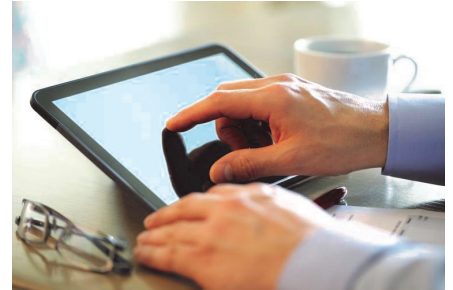


100 Big Ideas
